As a way of keeping you informed of what we are planning to do in our classes, we have put together a list of <u>some</u> of the activities we will be doing this term.

In Literacy

We will:

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- Continue with our guided and shared reading activities using Town Mouse and Country Mouse and The Three Little Pigs
- Write descriptions about our favourite rooms in our homes
- Write about famous buildings in N. Ireland
- Recount writing about our walks into and around Holywood
- Continue with phonics activities, including: spelling CVC and CVCC words (e.g. cat, jump, pump)
- Reading multi-syllable words and spelling words where the sounds are represented by more than one letter (sh, ch, ck, th ng, nk)
- Continue work on high frequency words completing outdoor learning activities
- Develop independent writing through our news and writing based on the topic
- Join in with Circle Time and listening activities

In Number Work

- Continue work on addition and subtraction
- Practise counting in 2's in odd and even numbers
- Continue to use Numicon to help with addition and subtraction
- Recognise and use odd and even numbers.
- Stories of numbers up to 7
- Count with 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins and use these coins in shopping activities
- Explore 2D and 3D shapes and discuss their properties
- Revise writing and drawing the times o'clock and half past.
- Complete pictograms and Venn diagrams
- Look at heavier and lighter than and longer and shorter than



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The themes are: Our Town and Country, Buildings and Homes. Some activities will include

- Turning the role play area into a Supermarket and a Tourist Information
- Exploring Holywood's amenities past and present
- Developing our map skills by making a plan of the classroom
- Labelling Northern Ireland counties

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- Looking at famous tourist attractions e.g The Titanic
- Recording and discussing weather and seasonal changes
- Turning the indoor and outdoor role play area into a building site and a B&Q store
- Using junk materials to create 3D buildings
- Making statues with plasticine

We will also explore

- Stories that Jesus told in the Bible.
- Celebrating Chinese New Year and World Religion Day
- Pitch and tempo in music.
- Using musical instruments through sounds games and songs
- Fundamental Movements lessons and gymnastics in P.E. using the apparatus
- ICT skills using computer programmes such as Just 2Easy
- Opening and using apps on the iPads and Interactive Whiteboard
